

Community Garden

Clearwater Community Garden evolved out of an idea to help the East Gateway become a fresher and more exciting community.

The groundbreaking took place in April 2015 and the Gardens opened in October 2015. It currently has 36 raised bed garden plots made out of cedar wood, an irrigation system that brings city water to each plot, and mulch covering most of the property. On March 8th 2016 a new shelter on the property was dedicated with a ribbon-cutting ceremony. The first garden manager, Jeff Harding, is an East Gateway resident
