First approved by voters in 1989, the *Penny for Pinellas* has added value to our quality of life and is going before the voters for renewal on March 13, 2007. This is not a new tax; it is a continuation of an existing tax that is paid by all who spend money in the county, including tourists who contribute more than a third of the revenue that stays in the county. Without the penny, we would need to rely more upon property taxes to make Pinellas County a better place to live, work and visit.
